Lincoln Theater invites qualified construction professionals to submit proposals for the renovation of the theater's historic (1875) lobby adhering to an approved architectural design. Fully designed and ready to build this project involves the construction of a new location for the concessions booth, plumbing, electrical, and the enlargement of several doorways. Work is to be completed by early-November 2025 in no more than a twelve (12) week period. Lincoln Theater will accept bids for a lobby renovation at Lincoln Theater, 2 Theater Street, Damariscotta, Maine until no later than 12:00 noon EST on Friday, February 21, 2025.

Bids shall be submitted on the attached bid form to Chistina Belknap, Executive Director, Lincoln Theater. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked:

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1. PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project aims to create an inviting, functional, and aesthetically appealing space that aligns with the non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization's mission to present diverse, high-quality programs that provide entertaining, artistic, educational, and social experiences that enrich our community. The project will enhance the visual appeal of the lobby, improve traffic flow and accessibility for patrons of all abilities, relocate and improve concessions area for staff and patrons, and update facilities while preserving the historical character of the building.

Completion Target: Mid-November 7, 2025

3. SCOPE OF WORK

Execution of the approved design (rendered by Archetype Architects), installation, and finishing.

Enlarge three doorways and create a new space for concessions involving electrical, plumbing, and ventilation needs.

A structural engineer has been engaged and once the existing wall and floor are opened they will finalize the opening requirements.

All subcontractors unless otherwise noted, including but not limited to electrical, plumbing, and mechanical are the responsibility of the bidder. Lincoln Theater is responsible for architectural, structural engineering, fire sprinkler & alarm services.

The following equipment will be sourced by Lincoln Theater and is outside the scope of this RFP: Food service equipment, chandeliers and lighting fixtures, and carpet. Installation is the responsibility of the bidder.
